- Traffic Congestion and Public Order:** Anticipating the potential influx of attendees, organizers must take proactive measures to mitigate traffic congestion and uphold public order. Proper planning and coordination with alike established business entities are imperative to prevent any inconvenience to residents and visitors.
- Ensuring Safety and Security:** The safety and security of all participants and bystanders should be of utmost priority. Organizers must adhere to strict safety protocols and coordinate closely with relevant authorities like RBP and Tshechu Business Committee to address any potential risks or emergencies effectively if required.
- Considering the Viability of Space Infrastructure:** Before submitting applications for any events, organizers should carefully assess the suitability and availability of venues. It is essential to choose locations that can accommodate the expected attendance comfortably without compromising safety or causing undue strain on infrastructure.

Paro Tshechu Business Committee will screen all proposals based on the above criteria. The above criteria are based on past experience of needing to promote public safety and lawfulness. Adherence to relevant laws of the land is minimal requirement.

By adhering to these guidelines, organizers can contribute to the successful and harmonious execution of any events while fostering a positive environment for all stakeholders involved. We appreciate your cooperation in making our community a vibrant and safe place for cultural celebrations and gatherings.
